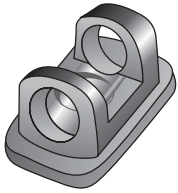

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ATTENTION: Please read warning label on the adhesive packaging before handling

INSTALLING MINI PLATE ANCHORS

1. Clean back of Mini Plate Anchor (a) and surface area where plate will be applied with prep pad (b). Dry with a clean cloth.
2. Evenly coat back of mini plate with the adhesive (c). Use the tube's application tip to spread adhesive toward the edges of the plate [fig. 1]
3. Adhere plate to prepared surface by pressing plate to surface for 2 minutes. [fig. 2]
4. Wipe off excess adhesive with Prep Pad.

Allow to dry for 24 hours before use.

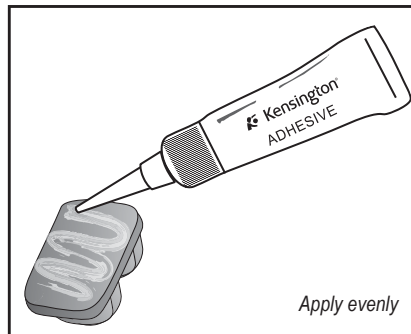

USING A SECURITY CABLE WITH A MINI PLATE ANCHOR



If you are using a cable that secures by utilizing a security slot:
Follow your individual cable's instructions and insert the cable's locking head into the slot in Mini Plate Anchor.



If you are using a cable that secures by other methods:
Thread the cable through both holes in the Mini Plate Anchor and secure according to your individual cable's instructions.
